For the purposes of ensuring clarity throughout this document, the following definitions are assigned.

"Augscape CKN / Our / We" means:

"GDPR" means:

General Data Protection Regulation Act.

"Data Controller" means

The natural or legal person who (either alone or jointly or in common with other persons) determines the purposes for which and the manner in which any personal information are, or are to be, processed

"Data Processor" means

Data specifically relating to services arranged and performed by Augscape are distributed to customers and subcontractors until the completion of services performed.

Data specifically relating to services arranged and performed by Augscape that has been distributed to subcontractors will become unavailable to subcontractors, following the completion of services performed.
